**SUMMARY OF POSITION**

Operate and drive a truck and RGN (removable gooseneck) trailer to safely transport oversized and/or overweight equipment to various locations in the LNVA canal system. Responsible for delivery, loading and unloading equipment, and may assist in routine and preventative maintenance of equipment.

**ORGANIZATIONAL RELATIONSHIPS**

1. Reports to: Canal Maintenance Supervisor; receives daily work assignments from the Equipment Coordinator Crew Leader.
2. Directs: This is a non-supervisory position.
3. Other: Has daily contact with other Authority personnel; has occasional contact with Authority customers.

**EXAMPLES OF WORK - Essential Duties**

- Maintain punctual, regular attendance and work the scheduled hours.
- Operate a truck and RGN trailer to transport oversized and/or overweight equipment needed for maintenance and construction of the canal system.
- Load and unload equipment and oversized and/or overweight equipment on or off RGN trailer before and after transports. Ensure equipment is properly loaded and secure according to all established State and Federal requirements.
- Obey all applicable traffic laws and drive in a safe manner, taking precautions needed for all weather and road conditions.
- Maintain all records needed to document pickups and deliveries.
- Perform routine, basic maintenance on equipment and may assist mechanic in performing preventative and routine maintenance of equipment, including refueling, lubricating, changing oil and filters, hydraulic lines.
- Perform daily Pre and Post Trip inspections of the truck and trailer, as well as inspections of the truck and trailer prior to and following each trip.
- Perform routine service of the truck and trailer, including refueling and checking oil and fluid levels daily.
- Maintain good housekeeping practices on all equipment.
- Complete and submit all necessary paperwork and reports accurately, legibly, and promptly.

**Other Important Duties**

- Operate Dump truck and other trucks with gooseneck trailers.
- Assist construction crews at work sites as necessary.
- Perform such other related duties as may be assigned.

**REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES**

**Knowledge of:** Commercial Driver License requirements, equipment operational and maintenance techniques; and applicable traffic laws.

**Skill/Ability to:** safely and effectively operate haul trucks and RGN trailer in all weather conditions; load backhoes, tractors, side boom mowers, skid steers, mini excavators, track hoes, and dozers; perform routine, basic maintenance on equipment; assist in the maintenance of heavy and light equipment; demonstrate proficiency in written and oral communication; read, interpret and follow maps; understand numeric data; complete necessary paperwork and/or reports accurately, legibly, and promptly; maintain appropriate Texas Driver License (applicable to job responsibilities) and good driving record; tolerate outside working conditions, including exposure to adverse weather conditions; and establish and maintain effective working relationships with other Authority employees and customers.

**PREFERRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES**

**Skill/Ability to:** safely and effectively operate tractors, backhoes, skid steers, mini excavators, trackhoes, dozers and side boom mowers; operate computer, including email, word processing, and spreadsheets (Microsoft Office Suite); use computer spreadsheets for data entry; and use Cityworks (GIS) programs.

**REQUIRED EXPERIENCE AND TRAINING**

High school graduation, or its equivalent, plus at least five years of verifiable experience working as a heavy haul truck driver.

*or* any equivalent combination of experience and training which provides the required knowledge, skills, and abilities.

**CERTIFICATES AND LICENSES REQUIRED**

Appropriate Valid Texas Driver License with Class A CDL certification and DOT Physical Examination (Medical card). Maintaining a Class A CDL certification and the DOT Physical Exam with Medical Card, is the responsibility of the all employees whose job require Class A CDL certification and DOT Physical Exam Medical Card.
